#### **Event Overview**

Making Waves is Los Angeles Waterkeeper's annual benefit to support our work and honor our water warriors who are safeguarding the region's waterways. #### Why Clean Water?

Simply put – water is life. Clean water is vital to the well-being of our communities and our coastal-dependent economy. Yet, 85% of LA's assessed waterways fail to meet minimum Clean Water Act standards; we continue sending billions of gallons of polluted stormwater runoff into our (often concretized) rivers and creeks and ultimately to our coastal waters every year; and the region is still overly reliant on expensive, environmentally harmful and energy-intensive imports for its water supply. While progress is being made, much more is needed to ensure every Angeleno has access to safe and healthy waterways.

#### Why Los Angeles Waterkeeper?

For nearly a quarter century, Los Angeles Waterkeeper has been the leading *on-the-water, in-the-water*, and *in-the-community* watchdog fighting to protect and restore our local waterways. Through our advocacy, outreach and programmatic efforts, LAW has helped protect LA's waterways from hundreds of thousands of Clean Water Act violations at industrial facilities; reduce sewage spills in the City of LA by 85%; ensure the adoption of cleanup plans for the region's most contaminated waterways; empower tens of thousands of Angelenos in monitoring and restoring to health our coastal waters and inland waterways; and is moving the region towards water-independence by pursuing a 'Reduce (*water waste*), Reuse (*stormwater*), Recycle (*wastewater*) and Restore (*groundwater*)' approach to our water portfolio.
